## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS

4. Parent(s) or guardian(s) of each learner at the school is required to sign the Code of Conduct and will receive a copy of it.
5. The ultimate responsibility for the behaviour of learners rests with their parents or guardians. It is required that parents and guardians:
  - 2.1 Acknowledge that they are partners in education with learners;
  - 2.2 Support the school and require learners to observe all school rules and respect the school Code of Conduct;
  - 2.3 Accept responsibility for any misbehaviour on the part of learners;
  - 2.4 Support the disciplinary procedures followed by the school provided that they are conducted in a fair and just manner, in accordance with the Labour Act, as amended from time to time. A copy of the Disciplinary Procedure is available on request.
  - 2.5 Take an active interest in their children's schoolwork and ensure as far as possible that learners complete assigned homework on time;
  - 2.6 Show a willingness to be involved in the school community by, for example, regularly attending meetings at the school;
  - 2.7 Support the school in all its activities wherever possible, for example, through participation when invited to do so;
  - 2.8 Ensure that the learner has the correct textbooks, stationery, uniform and all other requisites necessary for full participation in school life. Parents and guardians are also responsible for ensuring that these items are clearly labelled and marked;
  - 2.9 Ensure that their children arrive at school on time, and are collected promptly and punctually at the appropriate time. If for any reason this is not possible, parents and guardians are responsible for notifying the school timeously of this. Similarly, they are responsible for notifying the school if the learner is ill. Parents and guardians are responsible for the regular attendance of learners at school;
  - 2.10 Be responsible for supplying the school with all information relevant to the wellbeing and education of the learner;
  - 2.11 Be responsible for monitoring the progress of learners and letting the school know of any problems which are adversely affecting the learner's performance;
  - 2.12 Be responsible for paying school fees and all other monies on time to avoid the learner being suspended from lessons;
  - 2.13 Be responsible for upholding and respecting the ethos of the school at all times.
